Questions About Trees

Here are some questions to help you learn more about your tree.

You may not be able to answer all the questions about your tree.

TREES

- What is the common name of the tree?
- What is the scientific name of the tree?
 - Draw the tree.
- Measure the distance around the trunk of the tree.
 - Estimate the height of the tree.

LEAVES

- Is the tree deciduous or a broad-leafed evergreen?
 - What is the leaf shape?
 - Measure the size of the leaf.
- Are the leaves all the same shape and size?
 - Draw the shape of the leaf.

NEEDLES OR SCALES

- Does the tree have needles or scales?
- What is the difference between needles and scales?
- If the tree has needles, does it shed them every year?
 - Measure the length of the needles.
- What colour are the needles or scales?

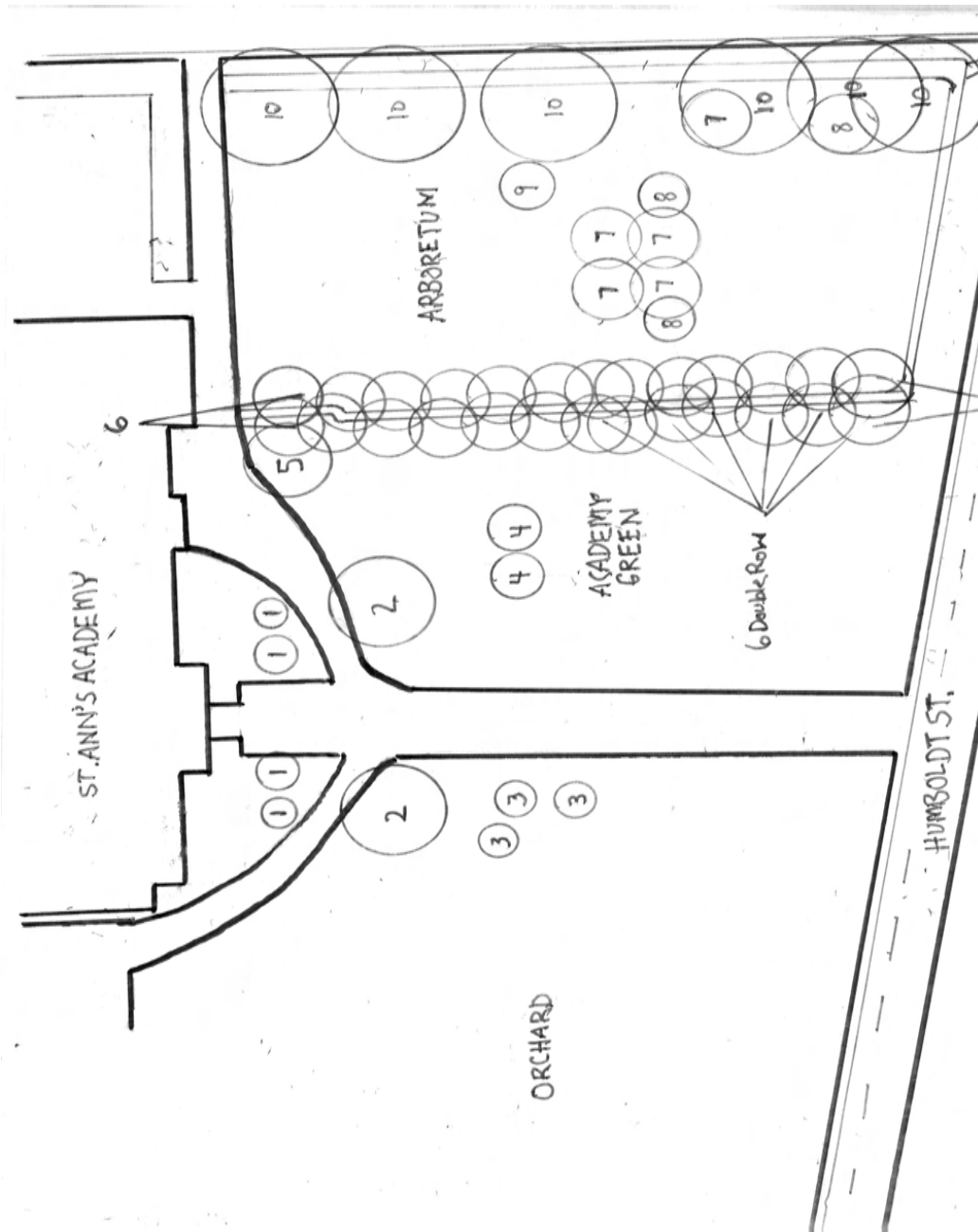
SEEDS, CONES, OR FRUIT

- What is the shape of the cone on the tree?
 - Measure the size of the cone.
 - Draw the cone.
- Are there any seeds in the cone?
- Can you see cones on the tree right now?
- Are the cones hanging down from the

- Describe the bark on the tree.
- Does the bark appear to be thick or thin?
- Does the bark peel or come off flakes?
- Is the bark grooved, and are the grooves horizontal (side to side) or vertical (up and down)?
 - Is the bark smooth or rough?
- What colour is the bark?
